Bangor Preview

On Sunday we will be heading to our local Point to Point at Bangor on Dee Racecourse. It's one of the best courses in the country and is always in fantastic condition, so we like to have plenty of runners. We are planning to have 7 runners on Sunday in all the races bar one.

The first race is the Open Maiden over 3 miles and we are running a newcomer called Late Romantic who we bought from Doncaster Sales last May. He has been working and schooling nicely at home and it will be interesting to see how he runs.

Threapwood is going to run in the Mixed open. He likes Bangor and was unbeaten there until I fell off him last time!! He wasn't going to win but might have been second. Almost all the horses entered are capable of winning the race so it should be very tight. If we get a strong pace, and the ground isn't too quick, I'll be there in the mix coming over the last.

There are 13 in the confined race and Sparkle Star will run in that. He won nicely first time out at Thorpe and is very capable of winning this. He unseated Ed last time but is none the worse and is going well at home so I am hopeful of a big run.

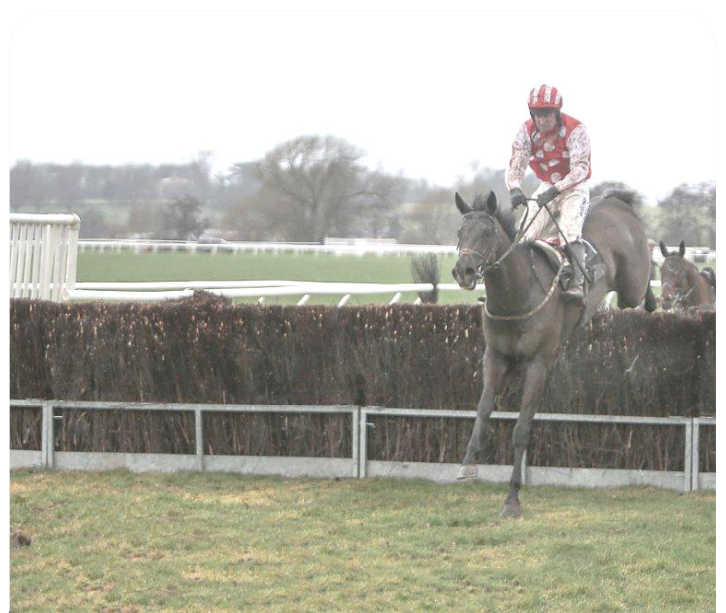
Our Crusade, who is owned by a local syndicate 'The Ridgeway Racing Club', has been running extremely well this season, and almost won last time in the Members at Bangor. He is going to run in the Intermediate. Johnny Og looks the one to beat. However we are going to apply cheek pieces, so he should travel better and could make all the difference.

We are going to run two in the Restricted, unless one goes to Brampton Bryan the day before. Desert Sting is one of the

entries. He ran a mighty race with Ryan on having his first ride to finish 3rd at the last meeting and should have a great chance. Alfapoint is the other entry. He pulled up last time but will be fitter this time and appreciate the better ground so we are hoping he shapes himself better this time.

Our last runner at Bangor will be Beware The Bear in the 2m4f Maiden. It has the most entries on the card with 16 and there look to be some smart horses entered. Bear has been working and schooling nicely at home and I am really looking forward to seeing him run.

It should be a fantastic day's racing and I hope plenty of you can come along.
